## What is Schizophrenia?

Schizophrenia is a serious brain disorder that distorts the way a person thinks, acts, expresses emotions, perceives reality, and relates to others. People with Schizophrenia may hear voices and see things that others can not, believe bizarre concepts are real, be fearful and paranoid, and may have poor self care.

Treatment for Schizophrenia Although there is no cure for schizophrenia, the treatment success rate with antipsychotic medications and psycho-social therapies can be high Medications: Atypical Antipsychotics Clozaril

# Treatment for Schizophrenia Medications: Atypical Antipsychotics

- Medications: Atypical Antipsy Zyprexa
- Common SE's; weight gain, or dizziness

- Encourage disclosure
- Increase feelings of self-worth
- Promote increased understanding (insigh

- Facilitate decision making
- Watch for cues
